Dear Resident or Property Owner:

This is notification that your street is part of the 2016 Village of Ashwaubenon Asphalt Paving Program. This program will include:

- 1) Catch basin, manhole, and curb & gutter repair, where necessary,
- 2) Milling the top 2" of existing asphalt roadway, and
- 3) Repaving the roadway.

The 2016 Asphalt Paving Program includes the following streets:

North Road:	Gerhardt Lane	to	Buffalo Street
East Adam Drive:	Packerland Drive	to	west end
Lama Court:	East Adam Drive	to	north end
Foxford Court:	Polo Run Terrace	to	north end
Polo Run Terrace:	Packerland Drive	to	Crosshaven Avenue
Finch Lane:	Lumber Lane	to	Circle Oaks Lane
Ken Drive:	Timber Lane	to	Ken Court
Ken Court:	Ken Drive	to	east end
Circle Oaks Lane:	Westmeath Lane	to	Finch Lane
Timber Lane:	Carole Lane	to	Circle Drive
Skylark Lane:	Circle Oaks Lane	to	Pioneer Drive
Oak Crest Drive:	Timber Lane	to	east end
Oak Crest Drive:	Timber Lane	to	west end
Canter Lane:	Cormier Road	to	Lina Lane
Lina Lane:	Canter Lane	to	Sandra Lane

Village crews have started catch basin, manhole, and curb & gutter work, and will continue into the month of July. Northeast Asphalt (NEA) is scheduled to start milling the above list of streets in July. This schedule is based on favorable weather conditions and will adjust according to the weather. There will be no street closures or detours during any phase of the street improvements; however, we ask that you avoid parking on the street during working hours (approx. 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.) as much as possible in order to facilitate the work and protect your vehicle.
