**COMMENDATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK-TREASURER DEPUTY
CLERKS, ELECTION INSPECTORS and PUBLIC WORKS STAFF**

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2020, Election Day in-person voting occurred for the 2020 Spring Election & Presidential Preference Primary; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Spring Election occurred amid the COVID-19 pandemic, causing unprecedented health risks as well as adverse planning and logistical issues in carrying out the foundational democratic right to vote: and

WHEREAS, due to the pandemic and leading up to election day, all Wisconsin voters were encouraged to vote by absentee ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer administered and processed thousands, upon thousands of absentee ballots as requested by registered voters as well as conducted in-person absentee voting; and

WHEREAS, Ashwaubenon's six polling place locations remained fully operational due to our self-less Election Inspectors dedication, who overcame adversity of the pandemic and tirelessly conducted the election process in noble fashion: and

WHEREAS, a great part of the success of the election was due to members of the Public Works Department who in addition to the set-up and break-down of polling place locations built twelve plexi-glass barriers to provide a safer election day environment for both voter and election inspector alike; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Ashwaubenon the Village hereby wishes to express its appreciation to the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer's Deputy Clerk's, the Election Inspectors, Public Works personnel and members of the U. S. Air Force and Army National Guard who also participated in our most precious principle of democracy.
