

## RESOLUTION No. R9-1-20 FOR ASHWAUBOMAY FISHING BRIDGE

WHEREAS, the Village of Ashwaubenon is interested in building a bridge that crosses Ashwaubenon Creek between Ashwaubomay Park and Aldon Station as part of the Ashwaubomay River Trail; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Ashwaubenon wishes the bridge to be used for fishing at the mouth of Ashwaubenon Creek; and,

WHEREAS, financial aid is required to carry out the project:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Ashwaubenon has budgeted a sum sufficient to complete the project; and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES Rex Mehlberg, Director of the Village of Ashwaubenon Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department; to act on behalf of the Village of Ashwaubenon to:

- Submit an application to the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for any financial aid that may be available;
- Submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation within 6 months of project completion date;
- Sign documents; and
- Take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the approved project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village of Ashwaubenon will comply with all state and federal rules for the programs to the general public during reasonable hours consistent with the type of facility; and will obtain from the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources approval in writing before any change is made in the use of the project site.
